

## *The important centres of French porcelain during the XVII and XVIII centuries*

### Saint-Cloud

Saint Cloud is known for its tender pieces manufactured during the XVIII century by the Chicaneau manufacture. The brand mark is a sun, later S.C.T

#### *Saint-Cloud porcelains are characterised by:*

- ▶ creamy and fat material
- ▶ 3D white enamelled pieces
- ▶ Seldom polychrome pieces

#### *Ornaments*

- ▶ 3D golden designs
- ▶ Blue lambrequins on Louis XIV shapes, often in 3D
- ▶ Raised gadroons
- ▶ flowers, sculptured flower garlands

#### *Shapes*

- ▶ cups, vases, boxes, knife handles and walking sticks
- ▶ bottle bucket



#### Saint Cloud

Potpourri vase, white enamelled, resting on a pedestal.

The base is decorated with sculptured gadroons and garlands, flowers and two lion masks.

#### Saint Cloud

Bottle bucket white enamelled with sculptured exotic flowers on a gadroon base. Handles are shaped in a Chinese smiling mask.



#### Saint Cloud

12 tender paste, polychrome knives, in the style of Kakiemon.

Birds and greenery foliage. Steel blades displaying a cutler's mark 'key symbol' and a silver ferrule.
